★★★ BALLOT OF RY 2008 - 2009 ELECTION ★★★

Important information before you complete the ballots:

1. There are three ballots for the elections of President-elect, Vice President, and Board of Directors, respectively, of Rotary Year 2008-2009, as outlined below. All listed candidates have been selected based on the criteria set forth in the Circular, dated 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2007.

1) Ballot for Election of President-elect

Please vote for only one [1] candidate. Any ballot with more than one vote will become void. The candidate elected will serve as a member of the board as President-elect for the year commencing on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008, and will assume office as President on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009.

2) Ballot for Election of Vice President

Please vote for only one [1] candidate. Any ballot with more than one vote will become void. The candidate elected will serve as a member of the board as Vice President for RY2008-'09.

3) Ballot for Election of Board of Directors

Please vote for seven [7] candidates or less. Please EXCLUDE the candidate whom you have voted for Vice President in the second ballot. Any ballot with more than seven votes will become void. The seven [7] candidates receiving a majority of the votes will be elected as Directors for RY2008-'09. The candidates receiving 8<sup>th</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> highest number of votes will be the Directors-In-Line in the order of the number of votes received by them, respectively.

4) The voidance of one or more ballot(s) will not affect the validity of the other ballot(s). Pres. Furniture and President-elect Bio (who will serve as President for Rotary Year 2008-'09), together with the newly elected President-elect, Vice President and seven Directors (total 11 members) will form Board of Directors for Rotary Year 2008-2009 pursuant to Article II of our Bylaws.

2. The ballot must reach the Club office before 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> December 2007. The ballots will be opened and counted and the result announced at our weekly meeting on Thursday, the 13<sup>th</sup> December 2007. Please return this ballot in the enclosed self-addressed envelope either by register-mailing or hand-delivering it to the Club office.

3. If you lost your ballot, please notify the Club Office immediately. At the sole discretion of Chair of the Nomination Committee, a marked replacement may be issued to you in person or by registered mail. If both the original ballot and the replacement are found in the ballot box, only the original ballot is counted. Your right may be affected if your lost ballot is not replaced.
